

Math and Science

In Math, students have been focusing on numbers 11-20 and how these numbers are made up of tens and ones. Students are also comparing shapes by how many sides and vertices the shape has.

In Science, students have made plant books on their iPads and are documenting the growth of their own plant in the classroom. They are also creating plant projects that display each part of the plant. Students will also be

documenting fall weather in their weather data folders.
