iPads: Students will begin to use their iPads this month for math and reading practice programs, projects, and work portfolios where students take photos and videos of their work.

Kindergarten students have been working very hard the past few weeks to learn classroom routines and expectations. They have been practicing important skills and social problem solving that will help them have a successful experience all year.

In language arts, students are practicing the letters found in their classmates' names during the "name game" each day. They are practicing how to hold a pencil correctly, and how to write a story using pictures.

In math, students have been focusing on numbers 0 – 5. Students are working on writing these numbers, representing them, and finding the smaller parts in the numbers. Students are also learning number games to help their number sense improve.

Pencil Grasp: A note about correct pencil grasp was sent home during Open House. If you notice your child holding pencils or crayons differently, please help them practice the correct way.

Homework: The calendar in the front of the folder tells you the homework for that night. Please complete homework **using pencil only**, unless it specifically says to color.
