Phase 1: Family Choice, In-Person/Distanced Instruction

Kindergarten - 5th Grade: Hybrid Schedule set to begin **Tuesday, February 2nd** for those families that selected **In-Person** instruction.

Tuesday/Thursday: In-Person Classes,
Monday/Wednesday/Friday: Distanced Instruction

Students attending in-person will be expected to be in **full uniform** on Tuesday, February 2nd: khaki bottoms, belt, academy shirt/fleece, black/white tennis shoes. Students will be expected to arrive with their iPad **fully charged**; however, they do not need to bring all of their school supplies from home. Students will be given supplies to use in the classroom on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Bus Transportation: Routes and stop times will be communicated to individual families next week

- reduced ridership
- assigned seats by family units
- masks required
- no eating or drinking while on the bus

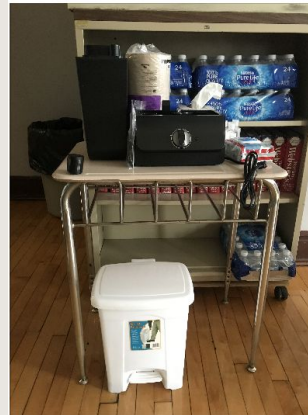

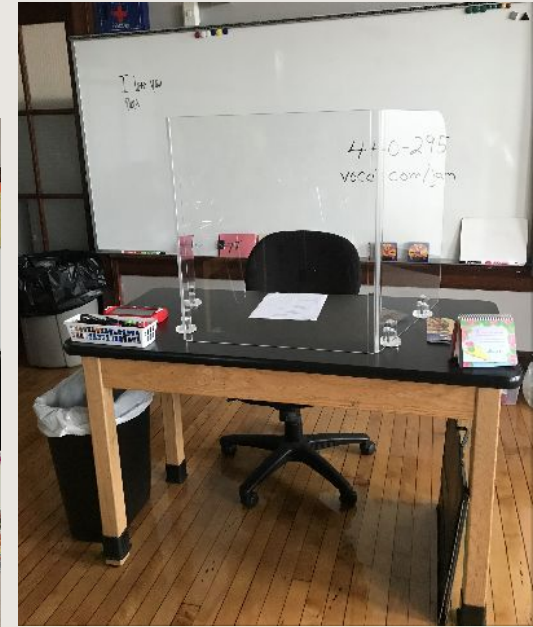

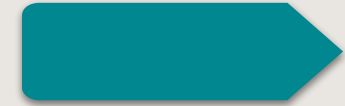

Phase 1: Family Choice (In-Person/Distanced Instruction)



*K-5 Students will be at AVN; 6-12 Students at AVS

*Temperature checks upon entering the building

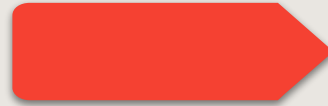
*Students will remain in class cohorts to minimize the fewest number of people moving throughout the building; K-5 recess will be outdoors with staggered schedules and minimized shared surfaces/equipment



*Face masks required at all times of all persons in the building; staff may also utilize face shields

*Hygiene station in each classroom; frequent hand washing and sanitation

*Social distancing of student desks; individual desk shields; social distancing dots throughout the building



*No water fountains; students will be provided with disposable water bottles

*Meals will be delivered to classrooms on Tuesdays/Thursdays; family meal distribution will continue on Mondays

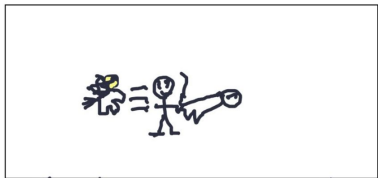
*Our school nurse and health room will be available to address any on-campus COVID concerns on a daily basis



*Sanitizing humidifier system in each classroom to sanitize the air each hour; UV wands to clean surfaces

*Limiting/prohibiting of visitors to the buildings; parents are to remain outside when dropping off/picking up students

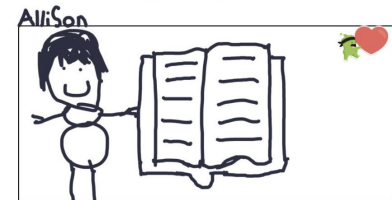
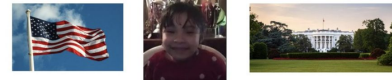
