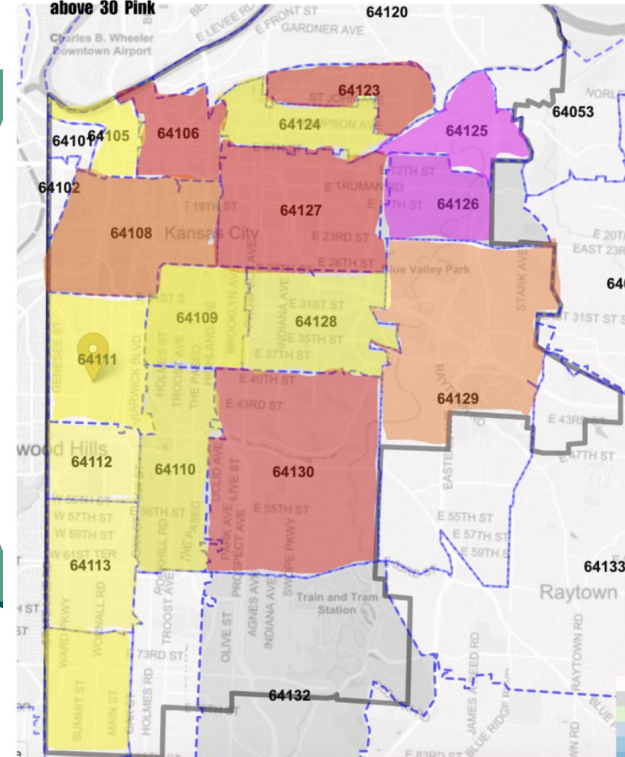

Safer at Home COVID Guidelines for KCMO:

ELEVENTH AMENDED ORDER



 Indoor gatherings limited to 10 people	Event-holders may request a waiver from the Health Department at kcmo.gov/waiveroverten
 Masks required inside & outside	Masks required in all indoor spaces with more than one person per room, & outdoor spaces where social distancing cannot be maintained
 Restaurants, bars, & event spaces	Must close at 10 p.m., & patrons must remain seated, and masked at all times except when eating or drinking
 Gyms, fitness, & recreational	Masks required at all times, & these establishments are limited to 50% capacity

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – Kansas City Mayor Quinton Lucas—in consultation with Kansas City Health Department Director Rex Archer, M.D.—today extended the State of Emergency in the City of Kansas City until January 16, 2021, as the City continues its work to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. This authority is granted under Section 50-155 of the City Charter. The [tenth amended order](#) signed by Mayor Lucas on July 10 remains in place.
